The following resources were inspired directly or indirectly by the *Perspectives* course or the *Perspectives on the World Christian Movement* curriculum. Each has the common theme of “unreached peoples” and connects people differently to God’s heart for the nations. Support for each comes from different sources.

Some of the resources below are for Bible study or use by individual local churches. Although they may be used for these purposes, some are more commonly used by more structured networks.

These resources are a part of the broader Frontier Mission Movement that has been steadily growing over the last 30 years, and many may also become part of the *Perspectives* Family. Introduced in 2003, the *Perspectives* Family is an affiliation of resources whose material and message aligns with a common set of core ideas. Materials that are a part of this Family will meet this criterion. As of March 2004, most on this list have not been evaluated. The *Perspectives* course and these resources inspired by *Perspectives* have played and continue to play a key part in the Frontier Mission Movement.
